CORRECTION ON STATE TESTING FROM LAST SUPERINTENDENT BULLETIN

The Connecticut State Board of Education adopted new science standards (Next Generation Science Standards) in November 2015. These standards replace the standards that were previously measured on the Connecticut Mastery Tests (CMT) and the Connecticut Academic Performance Tests (CAPT) in grades 5, 8, and 11. Our district has been selected to participate in the pilot test for the new standards. Students in grade 11 will participate in the pilot test during the month of May. The testing will take approximately one hour and students will have an opportunity to provide feedback about the experience. The results of the pilot test will be used by the Connecticut State Department of Education to develop and improve science assessments as a part of the state accountability system. If you have questions regarding this pilot test, please contact the test coordinator for your child's school.


