# **PARENT TEACHER CONFERENCES**

Parent/Teacher conferences at Tolland High School will be held on Thursday, November 2 from 11:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Students are welcome to attend with their parent/guardian. The purpose of the conference is to allow for brief interactions focusing on student academic performance to date. As the first quarter ends on Wednesday, November 1, the halfway point of the first semester marks a significant time to have a conversation about your child's progress. To schedule a conference time with one or more of your child's teachers and school counselor, you can access our online sign up called SignUpGenius via our school website by clicking on the yellow sign up button on the left side of our home page under a parent/teacher conference message in our announcement section. Each teacher conference is scheduled for 10 minutes while counselor conferences are scheduled for 15 minutes. If you already feel comfortable with the sign-up process, click on the yellow SignUpGenius button below to obtain the link which will take you directly to the ART Department page. To sign-up for a conference with a teacher in another department, click on the "Show More Sign Ups" on the right side of the page. You will be required to enter your name as well as your child's name in the comment box. To allow for adequate "passing time" from one room to the next, it is suggested that you do not sign up for back-to-back **appointments**. For example, if you sign up for an 11:30 conference with one teacher, please sign up for a second conference with another teacher using the 11:50 time slot.



If this process is new for you, directions can be found on the homepage of our school website at <a href="www.ths.tolland.k12.ct.us">www.ths.tolland.k12.ct.us</a> by scrolling down under the announcement section. Signups will close at 11:59 p.m. on Tuesday, October 31. Reminders will be sent from the program to the e-mail address provided two days prior to the conference date. If you feel you need a longer conference, please arrange to meet with the teacher at another mutually convenient time.

You can purchase a yearbook online at ybpay.lifetouch.com using the code for Tolland High School of 10945818. Price starts at \$75 and goes up from there depending on the package that you purchase. After October 30<sup>th</sup> the base price goes up to \$85. The base price will then increase to \$90 after February 5<sup>th</sup>. Make all checks payable to Lifetouch.

Nameplates, cover keepers and autograph inserts are \$5 each. You can choose the "Eagle's Nest" package for all three enhancements for only \$13.00. ## **CLASS DUES COLLECTION**

Class dues are collected during each of a student's four years at THS to help pay the cost of the student's senior expenses such as caps and gowns, the senior banquet, the senior picnic (including transportation), class t-shirt and class gift. Dues for the student's freshman, sophomore and junior years are \$35.00 each year. Senior year dues are \$45.00. Our intent in having a portion of the total cost due each year is to avoid yet another "big bill" at graduation time. Each year that a student does not pay dues, there is a \$5.00 late fee. The class dues collected covers only a portion of senior expenses. Additional money comes from fundraising events such as dances and shows sponsored by the various classes.
