## PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING:

BY ACCEPTING YOUR THS PARKING PASS, YOU AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Parking at Tolland High School is a privilege for any student with a valid CT driver's license. Any student needing a parking space must submit a <u>completed</u> application with a <u>check</u> for \$15.00 fee to the main office. Parking permits will be assigned in the order that completed applications are received. Students will be issued a Tolland High School hang tag which must be displayed at all times. The number on the <u>back</u> of the hang tag is representative of the number of their parking space. Students may park <u>only</u> in the space assigned to them (see map). Student vehicles must <u>NOT</u> be parked in grass areas, in fire lanes, or areas not assigned. The parking privilege carries the expectation that the student will follow student parking regulations, arrive to school on time and drive in a safe manner. Students who leave school during the school day without authorization, cut class, are tardy to school, drive recklessly, violate the student parking regulations or violate other THS policies and/or procedures may result in loss of parking privileges and disciplinary action. Failure to park in the space assigned will result in the car being towed at the owner's expense.
- 2. If a student's assigned spot is not available (i.e., due to snow, someone else parked in their spot, etc.) and the student parked in a spot not their own, the student must report to the main office (upon arrival to school) the alternate space number they parked in and the reason why they are not parked in their assigned parking space.
- 3. During the school day, access to cars, or the parking lots is discouraged. You are only able to go to your car with permission from the front office. Remember to bring all your books, homework and lunch money from the car when you come in in the morning.
- 4. The speed limit on school property is 15 mph.
- 5. Students are not to loiter in vehicles. After parking their vehicles, students should enter the building.
- 6. Smoking in vehicles on school property is not allowed.
- 7. Students must resubmit a THS Parking Permit Application if they change vehicles during the school year. There is no additional charge to update paperwork.
- 8. THS is not responsible and does not reimburse for lost, stolen or damaged vehicles and/or damaged articles.
- 9. EMERGENCY/FIRE LANES: Lanes closest to the back entrance of the school have been designated as an emergency/fire lane. Thus, it should remain clear at all times except for bus pick up and drop off. The parking restriction exists during both school and non-school hours on weekdays and weekends. Those cars parked in the designated emergency/fire lane may be subject to either loss of parking privileges or fines associated with violations of the Connecticut General Statutes.
